

Myron Stratton Home Standby Statement

The novel COVID-19 pandemic poses an immediate and real threat to the residents of the Myron Stratton Home, whose ages put them in the category of those most at risk for the serious consequences of this disease. Therefore, and in accordance with our important mission of protecting and caring for our residents, we have taken immediate and specific action to ensure their safety by implementing the following actions (among others):

- We are no longer allowing guests to visit any of our buildings
- All doors to the facilities have been locked (with safety access still functional)
- All residents and employees entering our buildings have temperature scans upon entry to ensure there is no indication of a fever
- We have reduced the housekeeping staff to a minimum each day
- Dining personnel have no resident interaction, limited personnel interaction and enter our facility through their own door
- Meals are now only served in resident rooms
- Any resident with cold or flu symptoms are quarantined to their quarters
- We have prepared two vacant rooms to provide sleeping quarters for our nursing staff should they be required to work for extended periods

We are committed to protecting our residents to the fullest extent possible during this period of time and may take further restrictive action, including but not limited to an entire lockdown of our campus, should that become necessary.
